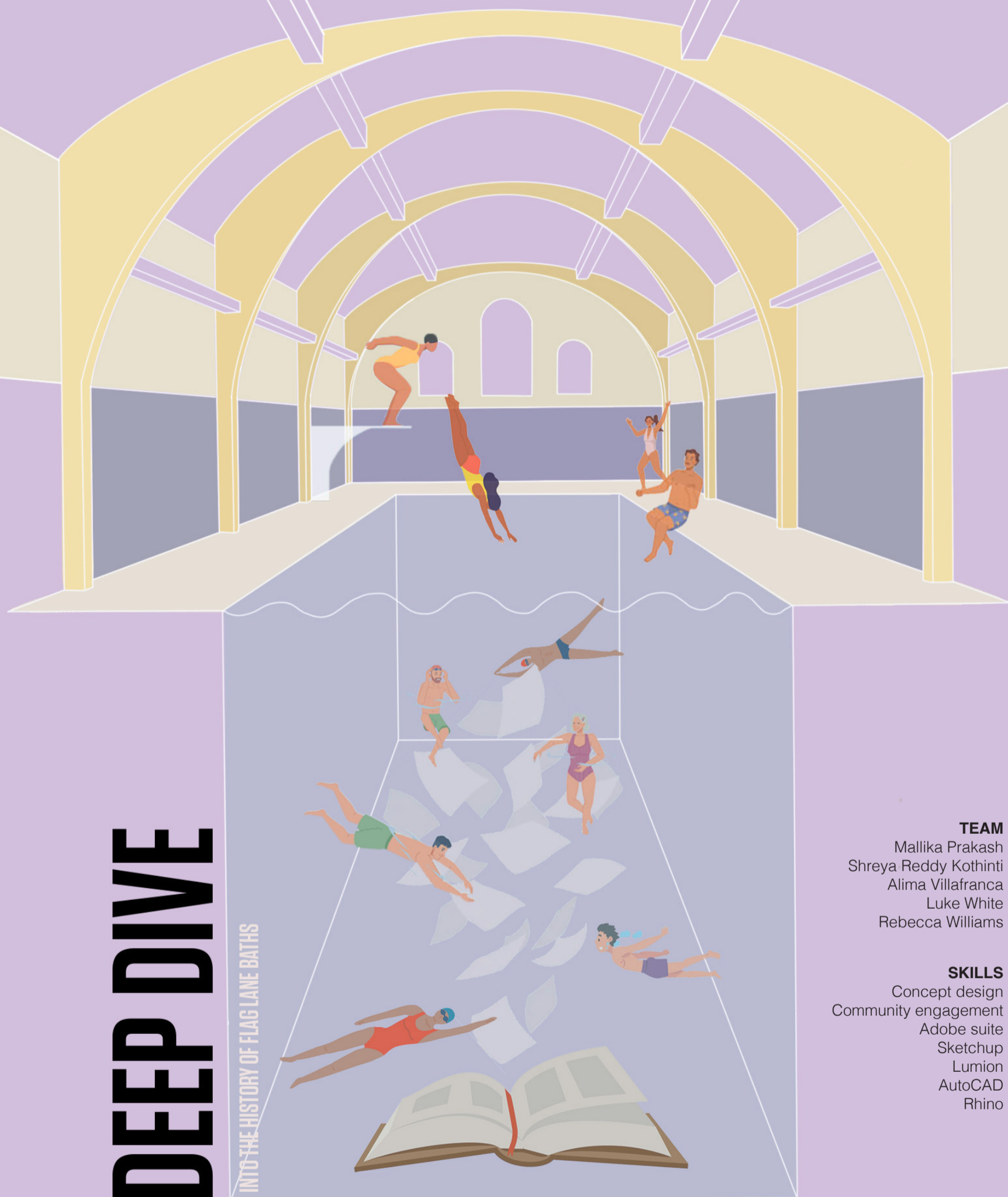


MANCHESTER SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE
