Growth Maps is an outdoor learning landscape that reimagines Moor Allerton Preparatory School's grounds as a living and evolving garden. The project aims to dissolve physical and social boundaries by weaving together biodiversity, play, and community. Through adaptable pathways, sensory planting, and outdoor classrooms, the space encourages children aged 5–11 to explore, interpret, and shape their environment independently or together. The “maps” grow through movement, seasons, and shared experiences connecting children, nature, and neighbouring communities. Over time, the garden becomes a collective map of learning, care, and ecological resilience.
